3. You may not roam, or walk around.
4. You may not invite your friends to come and sit with you while you are on duty. You must be available to assist parents, or others who need your help.
5. No eating or drinking at your duty station. This is unprofessional.
6. Dress code is tidy, and professional. Students who arrive dressed inappropriately will be sent home, and may not apply for volunteer opportunities for the remainder of the academic year.
7. You *must show up on time for all team meetings* prior to the event. Failure to do so will mean that you cannot be a volunteer.
